

# Summer is here and the heat is on!

The MCA swimming pool is open, clean and sparkling! We are happy to provide such a beautiful and healthy activity for our MCA members to enjoy. We also provide for our members pickle ball, miniature golf, ping pong, shuffle board, basketball and a nature trail. Inside activities include pool tables, and scheduled group activities, such as Busy Hands, Game Night, and Belly Dancing to name just a few.

The Meadview Civic Association is a members only facility. When you purchase a lot in Meadview it is either a membership lot, or a lot that can be adopted as a membership lot. All lots in the Meadview area fall under one of these categories. The lot is the member. As the owner of said lot, you have the privilege to use the MCA facilities. **The use of the facility is a privilege not a right; be courteous and respectful at all times.**

## **To provide the very best experience for our members there are just a few guidelines we all must follow:**

### Guests are defined as the following:

- A person who does not own real property in Meadview, Lake Mead City or the surrounding areas of Meadview.
  - ⇒ No person who owns property in either Meadview or Lake Mead City can be considered a guest to attend membership functions since that person may become an Adopted Member or a Social Member
- A person who is visiting an MCA member in good standing, comes to visit infrequently and does not primarily come to participate in one of the scheduled MCA functions or Clubs/Groups that use the MCA facilities.
- A guest must be accompanied by the member all the time
- Children must ALWAYS be accompanied by the member and/or they are a dependent of the member they are visiting

### Scheduled Functions that ALL persons may attend are hosted by:

- All Government Entities, Quail Club, Community Of Meadview (COM), and the Meadview Chamber of Commerce

### Service Animal Policy:

- Only Service Animals may enter the facilities. No other pets shall be allowed.
- **MCA regulation regarding service animals:**
  - ⇒ **All service animals must be kept off of the MCA furniture AND on a leash at all times.**
- Service Animal Definitions according to the U.S. Dept. Of Justice (March 15 2011):
  - ⇒ An animal "individually" trained to do work or perform tasks for people with disabilities.
  - ⇒ The animal must be harnessed, leashed or tethered, unless these devices interfere with the service animal's work or the individual's disability prevents using these devices.
  - ⇒ Service animals are "working " animals, not pets. The work or task the animal has been trained to provide must be directly related to the person's disability.
  - ⇒ Animals whose sole function is to provide comfort or emotional support do not qualify as service animals under the American Disability Act.

### Swimming Pool Area Regulations:

- NO Private Pool Parties (7/14/2001).
- All Children under the age of 12 years old must **always** be supervised by an adult.
- NO Glass in the pool area.
- NO Food or Alcoholic beverages shall be taken into or consumed inside the gated pool area.
  - ⇒ Alcoholic beverages are restricted to the upper terrace bar-b-que area and the auditorium only.
- All persons using the pool are required to SHOWER before entering the pool.
- NO cut off's, street clothes, hair accessories or shoes are allowed in the pool.
  - ⇒ Swimming suits & white t-shirts only.
- Please wait 30 minutes before entering pool after applying lotion or sunscreen.
  - ⇒ Oils or lotions clog the pool filters and stain the water line tile.
- NO ROWDINESS, RUNNING, DIVING OR JUMPING into or around the pool.
  - ⇒ It is dangerous and is NOT permitted.
- NO inner tubes of any kind, NO large floatation devices such as air mattresses.
  - ⇒ Safety devices and water wings for small children are acceptable.
- NO SMOKING, FOOD, BEVERAGES OR CHEWING GUM while in the pool.



## **OBITUARY FOR JOHN WILLIAM NEWELL (JACK)**

From his home in Meadview, Arizona, Jack made the trip to his eternal home on August 19, 2024. Members of his family were there to wish him a smooth and easy trip. Descended from early Colorado pioneer stock, and born on New Year's Eve of 1932 in Denver, Jack was 91 years old at his passing.

His parents were Ed and Winnie Newell; his siblings were Jean, Rich and Kay. Throughout his youth, he had nine cousins living in the Denver metro area. When he was 13, Jack was named the youngest Eagle Scout in Denver history at that date. He lived the Scout motto: "Be Prepared." He also held to the Golden Rule and an extended personal code that included *don't hurt others, don't tell lies, when you see a need, do what you can to fix it*. A graduate of West High School, he was a nationally ranked athlete in long jump and high bar (including for a time the U.S. Army long-jump record). He went to work for AT&T when he was 17, then served in Korea, then returned to work another 30 years for Mountain Bell. In 1955, he married Suzann Boardman on his 23<sup>rd</sup> birthday. They were parents of two children: Kelly Michele and Clayton C. 'Coke' Newell.



Initially trained as a medic in Korea, his electric-communications experience soon saw him transferred to the signal corps, where he helped erect communications networks to the officers on the front lines of battle. After his return, he was a Scout Master and a 4-H leader. After he retired

from the phone company, he and Suzann moved to Meadview, Arizona and for seven years he drove the ambulance for the Grapevine Mesa fire station. He led and accompanied the Explorers Hiking club for 30 years. To support the volunteer fire department, he helped set up and run the Deep-Pit barbeque for 15 years, and began and for 19 years worked with the 10K Walkathon. He called Bingo for 8 years; the money raised provided the money for insurance, truck tires, Turn-Outs for the fire fighters, equipment, helmets, radios, ambulances (used but useable) and money to finish the fire house in 1995. He was an early member of the Meadview Chamber of Commerce. As a member of the HOA governing board, he planned and built the miniature golf course (which is now named for him) and the disc-golf course and helped rebuild the kitchen and the new addition to the MCA auditorium. The Meadview community many times honored him in formal presentations for his many years of community service.

Jack is survived by his wife and two children, 11 grandchildren, and 25 great-grandchildren. One granddaughter preceded him in death.
